


Which two countries in the world have the highest human populations?





Access to education is an important part of development. Is 'literacy rate' a social or an economic development indicator?







Population can be described as either sparse or dense. Which one means somewhere is crowded?












True or False, the world population is expected to reach 8 billion by the end of 2022.
