Fjord Cruise: Bergen – Mostraumen – Bergen

On the way from Bergen you will have a great view of the famous Bryggen before sailing under the Nordhordalandsbrua on the Osterfjord, then enter the Mostraumen, where the fjord becomes really narrow. Sail past several waterfalls and around Osterøy, making a stop at Heskjedalsfossen, a twin waterfall.

Balestrand Fjord Sightseeing by RIB

1 hr 20 mins / Daily at 13:00 / Apr to Sept / operated by Balestrand Fjord Adventures

Setting off from Balestrand Harbour, you will see the mighty Kvinafossen, a waterfall with 120m drop before crossing the fjord to Vangsnes for a great view of the Fridtjov statue and on to the island of Kvamsøy. The return trip follows the shoreline towards Balestrand with its Swiss style villas.

The Nærøyfjord is one of the most famous fjords in Norway. You will cruise along the wide Sognefjord passing under steep mountains and as you enter the Nærøyfjord, known as one of the narrowest fjords in the world. Cascading waterfalls and lush green farmland surround you as you explore the fjord.

Classic Trolltunga
