Eirik the Red's Viking Ruins

3 hours / Mon, Tue & Wed / May to Aug

Cross Erik's Fjord by boat and go ashore at the sheep breeding settlement Qassiarsuk, situated on the very spot where Erik the Red settled in 985 AD and named his farm "Brattahlíð". We visit the ruins of Erik's farm and Thorhildur's church; the first Christian church on the American continent.

Qooroq Ice Fjord

3 hours / Daily May to Aug

The Greenland Ice Cap produces 250 millions tons of ice every year when icebergs break off the glaciers. Close to Narsarsuaq the Qooroq Glacier fills up the fjord with beautiful icebergs. Turn off the engine and cruise between the icebergs to enjoy the silence only disturbed by the creaking ice. Light refreshments included.

Hike to the Ice Cap

8 hours / Mon, Tue & Wed / May to Aug

This demanding guided hike suitable for participants that are able to walk at least 6 km in mountain terrain. We go by bus as far as the road will take us and continue by foot through the Flower Valley with its colourful sub-arctic flora. Lunch at the top of a 300 m high mountain with views over the glacier and the Ice Cap. For participants in good physical shape it will be possible to walk down and touch the Ice Cap.

Short Hike to the Ridge

3 hours / Mon, Tue & Wed / Daily May to Aug

We transfer by bus to the beginning of the ridge. Here we find a great variety of flowers and plants. From the top we have an amazing view over the Flower Valley, the river, the fjord and the Narsarsuaq Glacier.

Dyrnaes Peninsula Hike

3 hours / Daily May to Aug

A leisurely guided hike including a visit to a non-excavated Viking ruin, remains from the Inuit as well as the beautiful Arctic scenery. Hiking boots or shoes are recommended for this hike. Light refreshments included.

By Boat to the Inland Ice Cap

4-5 hours / Daily May to Aug

A guided tour by boat across the ice-filled Bredefjord to a fjord system northwest of Narsaq leading up to the impressive Twin Glaciers, where we go ashore on a small rock emerging from the glacier front. Continuing into another fjord with bird's cliffs and a big waterfall.
