## Ilulissat



### Ilimanaq and Whale Safari in Disko Bay

**6 hours / Mon, Thur & Sat Jun to Aug**

Enjoy a visit to picturesque settlements of Ilimanaq before setting off on a cruise on Disko Bay. A protected animal, humpback whales have become very trusting in these waters and, naturally curious, they often approach the whale watching ships of their own volition to take a closer look. Thus, this is an incredible place to enjoy first-class whale watching encounters at close range as a group of these cetaceans circle your vessel, feed undisturbed by your presence, or play together in the chilly waters. Please note sightings can not be guaranteed.

### Eqi Glacier and Rodebay

**7 hours / Wed, Fri & Sun Jun to Aug**

Cruise north from Ilulissat to visit the tiny settlement of Rodebay, home to fewer than 100 people dedicated to fishing and hunting. Continue by boat to the 5km wide Eqi glacier, one of the most active glaciers in Greenland with large and small chunks of ice breaking off throughout the day giving many photo opportunities. This area is also excellent for spotting whales and hopefully the gentle giants of the sea will put in an appearance. Lunch or dinner included.

### Coffee Mik – Home visit to a local family

**1.5 hours / Daily May to Aug**

A visit to a Greenland home is more than just stopping by for coffee, it is a glimpse at the local culture which has thrived on this northern island for centuries. You will learn first hand about the unique people who make this island home and how they have survived in this frigid and unforgiving environment. On your visit, you will be served a cup of 'Coffee-Mik', a cup of coffee which, by tradition, is served to all visitors.

### Sunset Cruise to the Ice Fjord

**2.5 hours / Tue, Thur & Sat Jun to Aug**

This cruise combines two of the Arctic's most impressive and iconic sights, icebergs and the midnight sun. Cruising through Ice Fjord, where icebergs of all size drift and shift through the waters, you will witness the marvellous colours of this ancient ice reflecting the reds, oranges, and yellows of the lowering midnight sun. The cruise will pass between the monumental wonders of nature and a late drink will be served to toast this once-in-a-lifetime experience.

## The Icebergs of Sermermiut

**3 hours / Daily May to Aug**

Travelling by bus, this tour will take visitors to the end of the road, literally. From here, you will get out and walk the brief distance to the fertile Sermermiut valley, where traces of four different old Inuit cultures can still be seen. A lush valley rich with plant and animal life, Sermermiut is settled next to Ice Fjord itself, world-famous for the tremendous icebergs that can be found here. Blending the incredible flora of the northern tundra with the spectacular shapes of the land's icebergs, this is a tour that blends colour and beauty into one remarkable natural experience.
